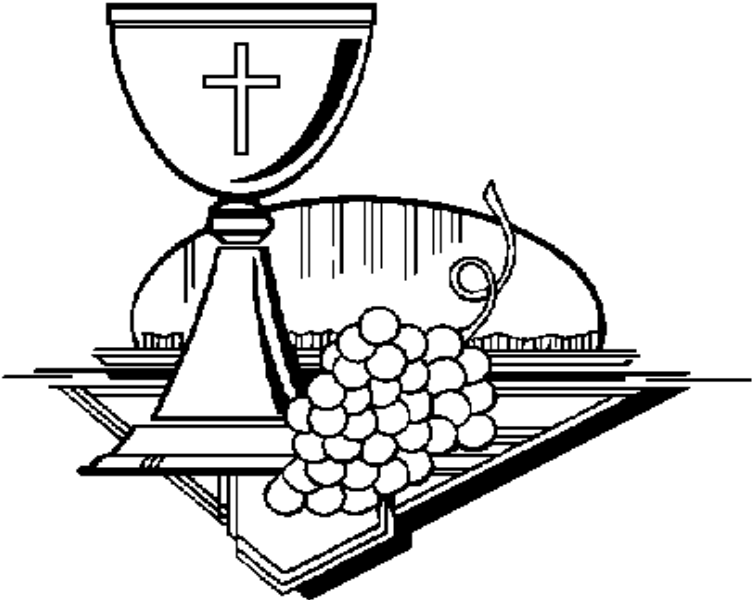

FYI: During the Nicene Creed, when we declare, "We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church", we are not referring to the Roman Catholic denomination—rather, to four distinguishing marks of the Christian church:
(1) It is "one", meaning that it is unified with Jesus as its head;
(2) It is "holy", in that it is Christ's "body" on earth, established to carry out His mission;
(3) It is "catholic", a word which means "universal"; and,
(4) It is "apostolic", in that the teachings and authority of the apostles have been conveyed and carried on throughout the ages.
